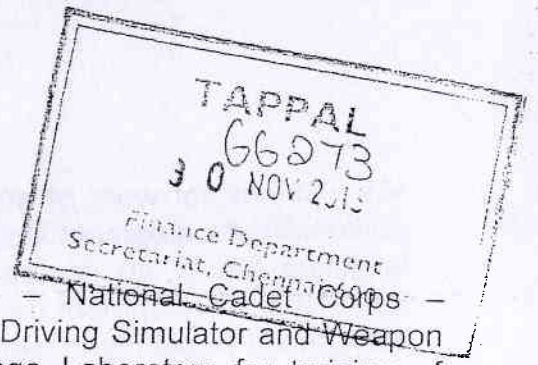

**ORDER:**

The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has proposed to introduce Simulator training to cadets to enhance their quality of training with much interest and enthusiasm prior to their actual handling of an aircraft, vehicle or a weapon. The simulators facilitate hands on experience to great extent thereby making the Cadets familiar and competent enough to handle the actual instrument. Further it would also reduce the cost of training to almost one tenth of the real cost. Same methodology is being effectively applied in the Indian Armed Forces as well. The following simulators for training of National Cadet Corps Cadets have to be installed by the Tamil Nadu Directorate at the National Cadet Corps Academy at Idayapatti:-

- (a) Driving Simulator
- (b) Flight Simulator
- (c) Weapon Simulator

2. Further the Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has stated that empowerment of youth comes with better communication skills. The cadets in the State who are outstanding in various spheres get left out in the National

Main Stream for want of effective communication skills. The latest training or personality development includes improvement of communication skills for which language lab is an essential component. With this innovative approach to personality development the youth of the state especially the cadets from rural background would immensely benefit from this language lab.

3. Subsequently, these schemes were announced by the Hon'ble Chief Minister under Rule 110 in Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly during Budget Session 2015-16.

4. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps has requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.85.00 lakhs (Rupees Eighty Five lakhs only) towards Procurement of Simulators viz. Flying Simulator, Driving Simulator and Weapon Simulator and also to sanction a sum of Rs.15.00 lakhs (Rupees Fifteen lakhs only) for establishment of English Language Laboratory for training of National Cadet Corps Cadets by the Tamil Nadu National Cadet Corps Directorate at the National Cadet Corps Training Academy at Idayapatti, Madurai District.

5. The Government after careful consideration accord sanction for a sum of Rs.1.00 Crore (Rupees One Crore only) to the National Cadet Corps Directorate for Procurement of Simulators viz. Flying Simulator, Driving Simulator and Weapon Simulator at a cost of Rs.85.00 lakhs (Rupees eighty five lakhs only) and Establishment of English Language Laboratory for training of National Cadet Corps Cadets at a cost of Rs.15.00 lakhs (Rupees fifteen lakhs only) at National Cadet Corps Training Academy at Idayapatti Village, Madurai under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for the year 2015-16.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following heads of accounts:-

**i) For the procurement of Simulators = Rs.85.00 lakhs**

8. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps is the Estimating, Reconciling and controlling authority for the above new head of account "2204-00-902-JA".

9. The Pay and Accounts Officer's / Treasury Officer's are requested to open the above new head of account in their books.

10. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. The Deputy Director General, National Cadet Corps shall send the detailed expenditure report, utilization certificate etc. to Government at the appropriate time.
