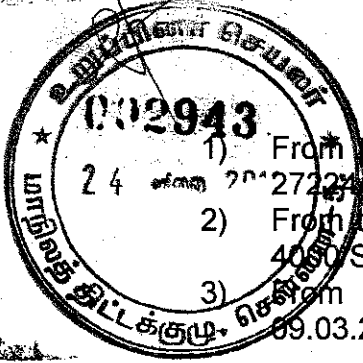

ORDER:-

The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has sent the proposal in the references first and third read above for "Long term monitoring of montane grasslands including establishment of field research station at Grass-hills area of the Anamalai Tiger Reserve" and requested the Government to sanction an amount of Rs.17.87 lakh under TANII - State Innovation Fund for the year 2018-2019 (Round-I).

2. In the letter second read above the State Planning Commission has recommended this scheme for assistance under TANII with staff cost for first year only. Accordingly, the arrived assistance under TANII is Rs.17.87 lakh including the maintenance to be done by the Forest Department as follows: -

3. The Hon'ble Minister (Forests) has made the following announcement on the floor of Assembly on 29.05.2018:-

“....ஆனைமலையில் உள்ள மலைச்சார்ந்த புல்வெளியில் நீண்டகால கூர்ந்தாய்வுப் பணிகளை மேற்கொள்ள ஆராய்ச்சி மையம் உருவாக்குவதன் மூலம் மலைச்சார்ந்த புல்வெளிப்பகுதிகளை அடையாளம் கண்டு, உரிய நில வரைபடம் தயாரித்து, அப்பகுதிகளில் ஆக்கிரமிப்புகளை அகற்றி, தாவர இனங்களின் தொகுப்பு மற்றும் மேலாண்மையினை செம்மைப்படுத்த வழிவகுக்கும். இத்திட்டம் 2018 – 2019 முதல் 2019 – 2020 வரை ரூ.17.87 லட்சம் செலவில் மேற்கொள்ளப்படும்”.

4. The Government after careful consideration, accept the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden and accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.17.87 lakh (Rupees Seventeen lakh and eighty seven thousand only) and release a sum of Rs.10.78 lakh (Rupees Ten lakh and seventy eight thousand only) for the scheme

under TANII - State Innovation Fund during the year 2018-2019, as annexed to this order.

5. (i) The expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2406 FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE. 01 Forestry, 101 Forest Conservation, Development and Regeneration. State's Expenditure. JE Establishment of Field Research Station for Long Term Monitoring of Montane Grasslands at Anamalai Tiger Reserve under State Innovation Fund – 09 Grants-in-Aid – 03 Grants for Specific Schemes

(DPC – 2406 01 101 JE 0933)”

(ii). The expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account:-

“2406 FORESTRY AND WILDLIFE. 01 Forestry - 902 Deduct – Amount met from Reserve Fund. State's Expenditure – JA Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund. 30 Inter-Account Transfers

(DPC – 2406 01 902 JA 3001)”

And Contra – debiting the following fund account :-

“J- Reserve Fund – (b) Reserve funds not bearing interest - 8229 – 00 – Development Welfare Funds – 200. Other Development and Welfare Funds – BE State Innovation Fund

(DPC – 8229 00 200 BE 0006) (Outgo)

6. Necessary funds have been included in the Budget Estimates 2018-2019.

7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para-4 above. He is also requested to ensure that the amount released therein is utilized in full and to send the utilization certificate as soon as the work is completed.
