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### ORDER:

The Mission Director, National Health Mission in the letter second read above, has stated that annually 5 lakh pregnant women approach CEmONC Centres in 31 Districts of the State. Pregnant women are amongst the high risk group people to contract Hepatitis B, a sexually transmitted disease. Detecting HBsAg in pregnant women helps in preventing fulminate liver failure and to include precautionary measures during delivery. It also screens the unborn child from chronic liver infection. Studies conducted in Madurai District proved the prevalence rate of hypothyroidism in females to be 11%. Therefore the National Health mission has stated that a pilot study on the pregnant women approaching CEmONC centres in the State, to identify high risk groups and focus on their monthly check-up and continuous treatment may be conducted and proposed the project "Testing of Hbs Ag & TSH in pregnant mothers in high performing CEmONC centres" at an outlay of Rs.420.00/- lakh to be funded under TANII. The State Planning Commission appraised the proposal and after detailed deliberation has recommended with the reworked outlay of Rs.232.50 lakhs.

2. The Government after careful examination accord sanction for a sum of Rs.2,32,50,000/- (Rupees two crore thirty two lakhs and fifty thousands only) for implementation of the project "Testing of Hbs Ag & TSH in pregnant mothers in high performing CEmONC Centres" listed in Annexure-I on Pilot Study under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII) Scheme 2016-17. The break-up details of the amount sanctioned are detailed in Annexure-II to this order. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Service is permitted to procure the components listed in Annexure-II through Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation.

3. The amount sanctioned in para 2 above shall be met from the State innovation Fund and debited to the following Head of Account:
