ORDER:

The Mission Director, National Health Mission in the letter second read above has stated that Dengue, Mosquito-borne viral infection is regarded as a major public health problem globally. It is transmitted by Aedesaegypti and Aedesalbopictus mosquitoes. The two main clinical manifestations, namely Dengue Haemorrhagic Fever (DHF) and Dengue Shock Syndrome(DSS), are responsible for exacting heavy morbidity and mortality every year and continue to be a serious public health problem. Therefore, it has been proposed to strengthen the Central Malaria Laboratory(CML) functioning in the DPH office, Chennai and Institute of Vector Control and Zoonosis (IVC & Z), Hosur to screen mosquito pools sent by designated Zonal Entomological Team (ZET) for the presence of Dengue Viruses. The total outlay of the project proposal is Rs.468.00 lakhs.

- 2. The State Planning Commission after detailed deliberations has decided to recommend the proposal by excluding the contractual staff. Accordingly, the project is recommended with a restricted outlay of Rs.378.00 lakhs. The Mission Director, Nation Health Mission has requested the Government orders in this regard.
- 3. The Government after careful examination accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.378.00 lakhs (Rupees three hundred and seventy eight lakhs only) Rs.288.00 lakhs is non recurring for the first financial year i.e., 2016-17 (Annexure-I(a)-(d)) and Rs.30.00 lakhs each for three financial years viz., 2016-17, 2017-18 and 2018-19 (Annexure-II (a)-(b)) for implementation of Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII) Strengthening Vector Surveillance in Tamil Nadu by Detection of Dengue Viruses in field Caught Mosquitoes under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiative (TANII) scheme 2016-17 as detailed in the Annexure to this order.
- 4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited under the head of account mentioned in the Annexure against each component concerned.

- 5. Necessary funds sanctioned for the current financial year 2016-17 (Rs.318.00 lakhs) have been provided in the First Supplementary Estimate 2016-17. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is authorized to draw and incur the amount sanctioned in para 3 above for scheme implementation.
- 6. The amount shall be met from State Innovation Fund by deducting under the following head of account:

- 7. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling authority of the new heads of account mentioned in the Annexure.
- 8. The Pay and Accounts Officer concerned is requested to open the new head of account in his books.
- 9. The Accountant General of Tamil Nadu is requested to make necessary book adjustment regarding the drawal of fund from the State Innovation Fund account.
- 10. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.8681/H-I/17, dated: 08.03.2017 and Planning Development and Special Initiative (SPI) Department U.O.No.1078/SPI/2017, dated: 15.03.2017.
