ORDER:-

The State Planning Commission has approved the proposal of the Director, Fire and Rescue Services Department, Chennai, for procurement of 5 specially designed vehicles for rescue works during inundation at a total cost Rs.127.50 lakhs under the Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives Schemes for the year 2016-2017.

2. In his letter read above, the Director, Fire and Rescue Services has requested to sanction a sum of Rs.119.00 lakhs as against Rs.127.50 lakhs approved by the State Planning Commission towards procurement of 7 specially designed vehicles for rescue works during inundation under the TamilNadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Scheme (State Innovation Fund) 2016-2017.

3. The Government accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.119.00 lakhs (Rupees One crore nineteen lakhs only) for procurement of 7 (seven) specially designed vehicles for rescue works during inundation for all the Regional Headquarters at Chennai, Madurai, Coimbatore, Vellore Trichy, Thiruvallur and Cuddalore.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited under the following new head of account, opened under Demand No.23-01.

“2070-00-Other Administrative Services-108 Fire Protection and Control – Schemes in the Twelfth Fire Year Plan-II. State Plan-JD-Purchase of Specially designed vehicles for rescue works during inundation –Scheme under State Innovation Fund-21. Motor Vehicles-01. Purchase (DPC.2070-00-108-JD.2114)”.

The above expenditure shall be met from the State Innovation Fund deducting under the following new head of account opened under Demand No.23 HOD:01

"2070-00-Other Administrative Services-902 Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund – Schemes in the XII Five year Plan-II. State Plan-JA Deduct – Amount met from State Innovation Fund – 30 Inter Accounts transfer [DPC.2070-00-902-JA.3008]".

and contra debiting J Rescue Fund (b) Reserve Fund not bearing Interest – 8229-00-Development and Welfare Funds 200 Other Development and Welfare Funds – BE State Innovation Fund. (DPC 8229 – 00 – 200 - BE 0006) (Out go)

5. The Director, Fire and Rescue Services is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling authority for the above new heads of account.

6. The Pay and Accounts Officers / Treasury Officers are directed to open the new heads of account in their book of accounts.

7. Necessary funds have been provided in Final Supplementary Estimate, 2016-2017.

8. The Director, Fire and Rescue Services is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 3 above. He is also directed to procure the 7 specially designed vehicles for rescue works during inundation by following the purchase procedures and codal provisions as applicable under the rules and orders in force.


