ORDER:

An Enterprise Business Acceleration Centre (EBAC) is being set up in EDI campus and will serve as the Incubator Hub for the State. EDI now proposes to support Business Incubation in Government Engineering, Arts & Science Colleges & Polytechnics in manufacturing technology related sectors for students and alumni as well as in the Private Sector. The objective of the project is to create an entrepreneurial ecosystem in the manufacturing sector through a network of incubators in Tamil Nadu besides to create an entrepreneurship node in higher education institutions for MSME / Start-up growth. The State Planning Commission has approved the model proposed by EDI. However the total project cost is Rs.25.00 crores for a period of five years. Whereas, as per TANII

guidelines the maximum ceiling on funding is Rs.20.00 crores only for a period of three years. Therefore, State Planning Commission has recommended the proposal for an outlay of Rs.20.00 crores for a period of three years. (1st year – Rs.5.00 crore + 2nd year – Rs.7.50 crore + 3rd year 7.50 crore). The additional requirement has to be adjusted through THADCO from the SCSP component considering the social responsibility involved.

The shelf of schemes recommended for the year 2016-17 (Round-II) by the State Planning Commission for implementation to Tamil Nadu Business Incubation Infrastructure Development Projects Cost is as follows:-

- 2. The Principal Secretary / Director, Entrepreneurship Development Institute in his letter 3rd read above has sent the proposal to sanction a sum of Rs.5,00,00,000/- under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for Development of Business Incubation Infrastructure Development Project in Tamil Nadu.
- 3. The State Planning Commission in the letter 4th read above has approved the Government proposal in its second round 2016-2017 as per the Government Orders issued in the first and second read above.
- 4. Based on the above approval, the Government accord sanction for a sum of Rs.5,00,00,000/- (Rupees Five Crores only) under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives for development of Business Incubation Infrastructure Development Project in Tamil Nadu.
- 5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"2851 – 00 Village and Small Industries – 102 Small Scale Industries – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan II State Plan MQ Development of Business Incubation in Tamil Nadu – Scheme under State Innovation Fund 09 – Grants in Aid -03 Grants for Specific Schemes"
