ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Joint Director (Additional Charge), Tamil Virtual Academy has sent proposal for “Tamil Text and Speech Computing Tool” at an estimated cost of Rs.70.04 lakh.

2. Tamil Virtual Academy has proposed to develop “**Tamil text and speech computing tools**”. The text and speech systems will be developed independently as two individual projects viz. Tamil Grammar Checker – 5 Modules and Assistive Aids for Visually Challenged People – 4 Modules. The Tamil Grammar Checker comprises of the following modules:-

I. Tamil Grammar Checker:-

- (i). **Traditional word grammar checker** (it checks தொகைகள், உரிச்சொல், ஆகுபெயர்கள், இடைச்சொல் இன்னும் பிற);
- (ii). **Modern linguistic word grammar checker** (it checks அடைகள், எச்சங்கள், சொல்லுருபு, தொடர்கள் இன்னும் பிற);

- (iii). **Checker / finder** for postpositions, adjectives, adverbs, particles, phrases, clauses, etc.;
- (iv). **Dependency grammar checker- Subject – predicate agreement checker** (it checks a subject and find the person, number, and gender in the predicate);
- (v). **Semantic Grammar checker- Dictionary of Modern Tamil Verbs with English meaning and Tamil usages**

The Tamil Grammar Checker is proposed to be implemented at a total cost of Rs.45.04 lakh. The break up details are as follows:-

II. Assistive Aids for Visually Challenged People:-

The Assistive Aids for Visually-Challenged People project aims to develop the following assistive aids to enable visually challenged person to read and write with ease.

- (i) Examination aid to enable visually-challenged people to take competitive exams in their native language.

- (ii) Screen reader that enables easy navigation through mobile phones and computers and assists in reading documents and contents from web pages with reduced processing time.
- (iii) Scanned document reader to assist in reading the content of newspapers, books, letters, or any scanned document.
- (iv) Typing aid that assists a user in typing content/preparing documents with ease, by recognizing speech.

The total cost for this proposal is Rs.25 lakh. The cost breakup details are as follows:-

In the letter second read above, the Member Secretary, State Planning Commission has informed that the proposal has been recommended at an outlay of Rs.70.04 lakh (Rupees seventy lakh and four thousand only) under TANII schemes for the year 2017-18 (Round-I) by the State Planning Commission for implementation.

5. During the Budget Session for the year 2017-18, the Hon'ble Minister for Information Technology has made an announcement that the creation of Tamil Text and Speech Computing Tools will be done by the Tamil Virtual Academy (TVA) at a cost of Rs. 70 lakh.

6. The Government, after careful examination accord sanction for a sum of Rs.70,04,000/- (Rupees seventy lakh and four thousand only) to Tamil Virtual Academy for the "Tamil Text and Speech Computing Tools" project under TANII Schemes 2017-2018.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

2202. General Education -03. University and Higher Education - 102. Assistance to Universities - State's Expenditure -KH.Tamil Text and Speech Computing Tools - Scheme under State Innovation Fund -09. Grants-in-Aid-03. Grants for Specific Schemes.

10. The Director, Tamil Virtual Academy is directed to furnish the Utilization Certificate along with detailed expenditure statement to Government. Any unutilized balance in the above amount would be transferred back to the State Innovation Fund Account.
