ORDER:

The following Project of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has been approved by the State Planning Commission under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Projects for the year 2017-2018 (Round I).

Production and supply of quality vegetable seedlings of major vegetable crops - An innovative approach - (Rs.277.75 lakh; 1st year budget Rs.277.75 lakh)

2. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has sent proposal as approved by the State Planning Commission and stated that in this project, the grafted vegetable plants of high yielding varieties / hybrids released by Tamil Nadu Agricultural University and also farmers' preferred hybrids will be produced in a mechanized way and supplied to the needy farmers. Skill training on grafted vegetable seedling production will be given to the entrepreneurs. Through the cultivation of grafted vegetable plants, it will be possible to maintain the plant population

besides resistance to soil borne disease and nematodes with extended duration of harvest. This mechanized grafted vegetable production technology in green house conditions will pave the way for increasing the production to vegetables and income of vegetable growers in Tamil Nadu. This approach will also help to reduce the use of fungicides and pesticides leading to reduction in the environmental pollution.

3. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for administrative approval for the implementation of the project viz., Production and supply of quality vegetable seedlings of major vegetable crops - An innovative approach and sanction an amount of Rs.277.75 lakh for the year 2017-2018 to take up the works according to the technical programme.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the request of the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University. Accordingly, administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.277.75 lakh (Rupees two crore seventy seven lakh and seventy five thousand only) for implementation of the project viz., Production and supply of quality vegetable seedlings of major vegetable crops - under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) Project during the year 2017-2018 (Round I).

5. The amount sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited under the following Head of Account:-

"2415 - Agricultural Research and Education - 01 Crop Husbandry - 120 - Assistances to other institutions - State's expenditure JO - Production and supply of quality grafted Vegetable Seedling of major vegetable crops Scheme under State Innovation Fund - 09 Grants in Aid - 03 Grants for Specific Schemes"

He is also directed to inform the progress of the work and expenditure made every month to Government.
