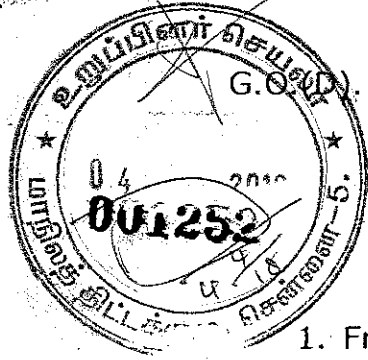

The following project of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has been approved by the State Planning Commission under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives (TANII) (Second Round) at a total cost of Rs.136.50 lakh for the year 2017-18.

“Skill Development and Employment Generation in Palmyrah Based Ventures for Rural Youth”.

2. The project includes the establishment of the pilot plant for production and processing the palmyrah which impart training to the rural youth for production of edible palmyrah products in Thoothukudi, Tirunelveli, Virudunagar, Ramanathapuram, Sivaganga and Pudukottai Districts. The Project also includes establishment of shade net house for production of quality palmyrah seedlings. The above said establishments are to be established in Agricultural College & Research Institute,



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Killikulam and Dryland Agricultural Research Institute, Chettinad of Tamil Nadu Agricultural University. The commitment under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives is only Rs.136.50 lakh for equipment cost.

3. The Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders for administrative approval for the implementation of the project viz., Skill Development and Employment Generation in Palmyrah Based Ventures for Rural Youth and release an amount of Rs.136.50 lakh for the year 2017-18 to implement the above project.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the request of the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University. Accordingly, administrative approval is accorded for implementation of the project viz., Skill Development and Employment Generation in Palmyrah Based Ventures for Rural Youth and also financial sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.136.50 lakh (Rupees one hundred and thirty six lakh and fifty thousand only) under Tamil Nadu Innovation Initiatives project during the year 2017-18.
