### **ORDER:**

- 2.The SADP focus on sectors such as Soil Conservation, Forestry and Ecology, Horticulture, Agriculture, Adi-Dravidar and Tribal Welfare, Animal Husbandry, Renewable Energy, Rural Roads, Gap-filling infrastructure in Urban and Rural Local Bodies, Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business, Water Resources Development and Fisheries.
- 3.The Special Area Development Programme (SADP) has the objectives of eco-preservation and eco-restoration with a focus on sustainable use of biodiversity, the needs and aspirations of local communities, ensuring community participation in the design and implementation of strategies for conservation of biodiversity and sustainable livelihoods, watershed based development on a participatory approach for ensuring efficiency, transparency and accountability in various indicative schemes and implementing agencies have been incorporated in the Government Order first read above.

In keeping with the objectives of SADP, during the 12<sup>th</sup> State Level Empowered Committee meeting held on 2.2.2021, among other projects proposed and recommended for placing in the SLEC for approval, the project proposals of the Executive Director, TEA BOARD, Coonoor for the project of "special package to benefit the progressive small tea growers of the Nilgiris District (Kotagiri Block)" for a cost of Rs.1.21 crores have been approved under "Livelihood Opportunity- NLG20AGRO78". Besides the above to implement the above work, the SLEC has also agreed inclusion of TEABOARD as an Implementing Agency for undertaking the works under Special Area Development Programme.

5.In the Government Order 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, orders have been issued approving the Principal Secretary / Managing Director, INDCOSERVE, Coonoor and a sector implementing agency under SADP and Joint Director / Deputy Director of Health Department as additional sector implementing agency for the purpose of taking up the projects for effective implementation under Special Area Development Programme.
