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### **ORDER:**

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued for the formulation of a new scheme called SADP with guidelines for administration and field implementation of the above programme. The guidelines for the implementation of SADP were issued in the Government Order first read above. The Department of Planning, Development and Special Initiatives of the Government of Tamil Nadu is the State Level Nodal Department (SLND) for the management of the Special Area Development Programme.

The SADP focus on sectors such as Soil Conservation, Forestry and Ecology, Horticulture, Agriculture, Adi-Dravidar and Tribal Welfare, Animal Husbandry, Renewable Energy, Rural Roads, Gap-filling infrastructure in Urban and Rural Local Bodies, Agricultural Marketing and Agri Business, Water Resources Development and Fisheries.

The Special Area Development Programme (SADP) has the objectives of eco-preservation and eco-restoration with a focus on sustainable use of biodiversity, the needs and aspirations of local communities, ensuring community participation in the design and implementation of strategies for conservation of biodiversity and

sustainable livelihoods, watershed based development on a participatory approach for ensuring efficiency, transparency and accountability in various indicative schemes and implementing agencies have been incorporated in the Government Order first read above.

In keeping with the objectives of SADP and minutes of the 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> SLEC meeting on 06.02.2020, 17.02.2020 and 16.03.2020 the construction of Tea Green Leaf collection Sheds, purchase of Mini trucks for food truck business for strengthening of Public Health services in Hill and Forest areas under SADP projects were sanctioned by State Level Empowered Committee for Livelihood and Health purposes as communicated in the minutes in reference third and fourth read above.

In the reference sixth read above the Project Director, Special Area Development Programme, Unit-I has proposed the Principal Secretary / Managing Director, INDCOSERVE, Coonoor as a sector implementing agency under SADP and Joint Director / Deputy Director of Health Department as additional sector implementing agency so as to be able to take up the projects approved under Special Area Development Programme.

In the 9<sup>th</sup> State Level Empowered Committee meeting held on 16.03.2020 and the minutes was approved to include TNeGA as an implementing agency for preparation of District Integrated Plans to better address issues in the SADP area providing it. In the reference seventh read above, the HoD (LU), State Planning Commission, SADP Unit-II has proposed the Managing Director / Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency (TNeGA) as a implementing agency for preparation of District Integrated Plans for SADP Districts.

7. The implementing agencies listed in the Government Order in reference first read above, need revision to take up the execution of these approved works. The Government after careful examination and accept the request of the Project Director, SADP Unit-I and the HoD (LU), SPC, SADP Unit-II and accords the following addendum:
